BACKGROUND:

1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1 In this Cookie Policy, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

“Cookie”	Means, a small file placed on your computer or device by our site when you visit certain parts of our site and/or when you use certain features of our site;
“Cookie Law”	Means, the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 and of EU Regulation 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”);
“personal data”	Means, any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data, as defined by the Data Protection Act 1998 OR EU Regulation 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”); and
“We/Us/Our”	Means, Touring Solutions Ltd a company registered in England under Company registration No : 04693036, whose registered address is 4th Floor, 18 St. Cross Street, London EC1N 8UN and whose main trading address is Unit DC3, Prologis Park, Dawley Road, Hayes UB3 1HH

2. Information About Us

3. **How Does Our Site Use Cookies?**

- 3.1 Our site may place and access certain first party cookies on your computer or device. First party cookies are those placed directly by us and are used only by us. We use cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of our site and to provide and improve our products and services. We have carefully chosen these cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and personal data is protected and respected at all times.
- 3.2 By using our site, you may also receive certain third party cookies on your computer or device. Third party Cookies are those placed by websites, services, and/or parties other than us. Third party Cookies are used on our site for advertising and security services. For more details, please refer to section 4 below.
- 3.3 All Cookies used by and on our site are used in accordance with current cookie law. We may use some or all of the following types of cookie:
 - 3.3.1 **Strictly Necessary Cookies**

A Cookie falls into this category if it is essential to the operation of our site, supporting functions such as security, logging in, your shopping basket, and payment transactions.
 - 3.3.2 **Analytics Cookies**

It is important for us to understand how you use our site, for example, how efficiently you are able to navigate around it, and what features you use. Analytics Cookies enable us to gather this information, helping us to improve our site and your experience of it.
 - 3.3.3 **Functionality Cookies**

Functionality Cookies enable us to provide additional functions to you on our site such as personalisation and remembering your saved preferences. Some functionality cookies may also be strictly necessary cookies, but not all necessarily fall into that category.
 - 3.3.4 **Third Party Cookies**

Third party Cookies are not placed by us; instead, they are placed by third parties that provide services to us and/or to you. Third party Cookies may be used by advertising services to serve up tailored advertising to you on our site, or by third parties providing analytics services to us (these cookies will work in the same way as analytics cookies described above).
 - 3.3.5 **Persistent Cookies**

Any of the above types of cookie may be a persistent cookies. Persistent Cookies are those which remain on your computer or device for a predetermined period and are activated each time you visit our site.
 - 3.3.6 **Session Cookies**

Any of the above types of cookie may be a session cookies. Session Cookies are temporary and only remain on your computer or device from the point at which you visit our site until you close your browser. Session Cookies are deleted when you close your browser.
- 3.4 Cookies on our site are not permanent and will expire as indicated in the table below.

svSession	This is a Persistent Cookie which identifies the number of different visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site. It does not track user personal details but only the user's presence in the website. It expires after 2 years.	No
ssr-caching	This is a session cookie used by wix.com to enable efficient navigation around the site.	Yes
bSession	This is a Session Cookie and is used to ensure visitor browsing security.	Yes
